

2021-2022 School Year



Dear Parents,

Thank you for your interest in Stone Church Preschool. Enclosed you will find information about the school, an enrollment application and health form for the upcoming 2021-22 school year. The preschool operates on an open enrollment basis as spaces are available. To reserve your child's place, please return enrollment application, survey, medical exam, immunization record and enrollment fee back to the preschool.

At orientation you will receive a preschool handbook giving you more details about the school policies, activities and curriculum or you can view the handbook on our website. The complete preschool calendar with dates for holidays, winter and spring break days for the upcoming school year will also be available at orientation and on our website. If you have any questions about the school, or would like to take a tour before enrolling, please call our office at 816-461-0150. School will be closed between May 21st and August 1st. The office will be open occasionally, but if you leave a phone number or an e-mail message someone will get back to you as soon as possible. Tours will be available by appointment only.

Stone Church Preschool is a 501 (c)(3), not-for-profit, organization. We rely on tuition, fundraisers and donations for funding of our quality preschool.

We offer a half-day preschool program, a full-day preschool program and early morning drop off needed. Students will have the opportunity to attend 2, 3 or 5 days per week. Please see the class option page for classes and rates. The first day for Monday/Wednesday/Friday students will be Wednesday, September 1st. Doors will open at 9:00 am. The first day for Tuesday/Thursday students will be Thursday, September 2nd.

The 2021-2022 school year will begin with New Parent Orientation in the evening, on Thursday, August 26th at 6:30 pm at the preschool. This will be about an hour long session where the students will go play with the teachers while the parents will attend a meeting with the director. This is a required meeting for new parents to attend with their children in order to learn more about the school and upcoming events.

You will also have an opportunity to attend Meet the Teacher Night on Friday, August 27th at 6:30 pm. Come visit all the classrooms and talk with the teachers.

The Missouri Department of Health requires that our school have immunization records or exemption record and a physical evaluation form, signed by a physician, for all children enrolled. Please have the medical exam form signed and completed by your child's physician along with a copy of your child's immunization record or immunization exemption card before your child's first day of school. Returning students will need to have an updated immunization record or immunization exemption card. Pursuant to state law, children without the proper immunization records will not be allowed to attend preschool.
